CHAINSAW TIP SHEET

Always read manufacturer's instruction manual in full.

Before operating your chainsaw, ensure that you are wearing the appropriate safety clothing required for your safety. **MINCOST** Trained staffs are on hand to guide any enquiries as to the legal requirements for employers and employees in regards PPE (Personal Protective Equipment).

Always ensure that the fuel you put into your **STIHL** chainsaw is clean and mixed to the correct ratio of 50:1. For best results always use **STIHL** 2-stroke oil, your saw has been designed to operate at full capacity with this quality of oil. Use of inferior oils can cause premature engine wear and poor performance, even increased consumption of fuel and increased emissions. Engine damage due to incorrect oil mix or inferior oil use **DOES NOT** constitute for manufacturers warranty.

Unleaded fuel becomes stale quickly when stored, for best results **MINCOST** recommends the use of Briggs and Stratton fuel additive for periods of non-use over a month to protect machine. (Please note that faults caused by stale or contaminated fuel are not covered by manufacturers warranty).

The saws safety chain brake should be engaged (pushed fully forward) when not in use and for starting as specified in operating instructions, this brake should always be disengaged (pulled fully back) when preparing to cut. If when attempting cutting the chain doesn't want to move (ensure brake handle is fully back). As the saws chain brake does not come into contact with machine during normal operation any damage caused to this area due to overheating is catastrophic and as a direct result of operator abuse and **DOES NOT** constitute manufacturers warranty.

As stated in operator's manual your chainsaw requires regular maintenance, **MINCOST** has taken the time to provide you with a brief guide to maintenance and operation by listing the tools and consumables that you will require during the saws serviceable operation life, available within store. Other services such as chain sharpening and servicing can be carried out at Steve Virgo Garden Machinery 01594 840500.
